

## Technology Advisory Board Candidates Sought

The Board of Selectmen (BOS) seeks potential candidates for a new Technology Advisory Board (TAB). This Board will consist of three to five members with complementary skills to be appointed by the BOS to staggered three-year terms and several stakeholders.

**Mission:** The Technology Advisory Board will address technology development within the Town and coordinate its actions with all independently elected Boards and Commissions.

The TAB shall advise the BOS, Town Administrator and other senior administrative staff, as appropriate, on resources and priorities concerning all aspects of computing, information management, and communication technology. It will also review and make recommendations concerning the Town's planning and implementation of plans for current and proposed computing and information technologies. The TAB's goals include the enhancement of Town processes, through the effective use of technology, to maximize effectiveness and minimize unnecessary redundancy and cost. The TAB's recommendations should support the goals and objectives of the Town for the proper use of computing resources by staff. The TAB shall also be a source of input and feedback regarding matters of administrative computing, communication, and information technology needs and requirements.

**Candidate Profile:** The Board is looking for individuals who possess experience creating and maintaining an overall technology strategy and multi-year implementation plan. Candidates should also have the time that will be required to get TAB up and running effectively. The BOS believes that individuals with professional experience in any of the following areas would help make an effective Advisory Board.

- Strategic technology platforms
- Municipal systems
- Communication systems and channels
- Data and information management
- Networks and data storage, including cloud computing
- Software
- Project Management
- Outsourcing
- Vendor management
