Treasurer's Report/Deposit Trailer: Fran sent out Treasure's Report early this morning but no one could access it. **Will re-send.** The trailer was not manned properly in the month of August, and committee members agreed that the Field Hockey team will be taken off the list. August is a tough month, but a member of the designated team/organization needs to work the trailer every day the TS is open. **Fran will talk to other groups on the waiting list to offer up the August slot.**

Transfer Station/Swap Shop: Christine coordinated a High School student to work the Swap Shop during the summer, which proved to be extremely effective in keeping the area neat and clean.

Website: Christine asked that **all committee members review the content of our section of the Dover website.**

Schools: Becky will take over Kerry's role in the Middle School and High School. Will discuss new lunchroom bins with Ralph and work closely with Ardys Flavelle of the Sherborn Recycling Committee to make sure that each classroom is equipped with recycling bins. Will work with the Recycling Task Force at Chickering to continue Waste Free Lunches – Becky Peterson will become more involved with this.

Dover Town Center Recycling: Big blue bins were placed in front of the Dover Market and Dover Deli in July. Craig Hughes supplied larger plastic bags and P&R is maintaining every Wednesday. Craig said that the bins are full, but better signage needs to be in the stores reminding patrons to recycle outside.
