

DOVER CEMETERY COMMISSIONERS MINUTES

MINUTES of the November 17, 2009 meeting were approved.

CITIZENS COMMENTS: Kate Bush stopped in from the Warrant Committee and she was in to reinforce our finalized 2011 budget. Ken Seaman was at the meeting to express his desire for us to move on the underground wiring for Dover Farms. We told him we would get it on the agenda at a later date.

NEW BUSINESS –

Commissioners signed the Bill and Payroll Warrants.

Work on finalizing the budget was the main focus of this meeting in preparation for the January Warrant meeting. The meeting is scheduled for January 20, 2010 at 7:00 pm – Carol and Jon plan on being at it.

Tree Pruning bids were received and reviewed. It was so voted to hire Davey Tree for pruning at a cost of \$2,065 and fertilizing at a cost of \$150, for a total cost of \$2,215.
