

Minutes of the Town of Dover, Board of Health meeting for April 12, 2010.

Present: Dr. Barbara Roth-Schechter, Chairperson; Dr. Joseph Musto, Member; Dr. Harvey George, Member; Mike Angieri, Agent for Septic Systems and Joe Fryer Agent for Wells.

Meeting Called to Order at 7:00 PM

- 1) Minutes of the March 22, 2010 meeting were approved.
- 2) 270 Dedham Street. Project was listed as having a public hearing scheduled but no one was present.
- 3) Deed restriction for 71 Main Street was approved and signed.
- 4) Deed restriction for 10 Wakeland Road was approved and signed.
- 5) 31 Old Farm Road, Preliminary discussion for septic system up-grade. Bob Vey of Norfolk Engineering presented a plan for the up-graded septic system and discussed issues with the Board. They will return for a public hearing which requires variances from Dover regulations and local up-grade approval.
- 6) Lyme disease up-date. A meeting was held with large town land holders to discuss deer herd management. All were in favor of the proposed actions to reduce deer herd size and risk of Lyme disease caused by over population. Massachusetts Wildlife will set up the plan but the town will manage it. There will be a May 19, 2010 7:00 PM meeting with Massachusetts Wildlife at in the Lower Level Conference Room of Town Hall at which time they will discuss the management program.

Dr. Harvey George and Dr. Roth-Schechter presented the tentative deer Management plan to the Board of Selectmen on April 8, 2010. The Selectmen supported the plan and will provide assistance as needed.

- 7) Staff Discussion. Dr. Roth-Schechter discussed Diane Fielding's family leave which will be in effect until May 6, 2010.
- 8) The Board approved a motion to give Dave Ramsey permission to sign pay requests.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:45 PM.
