1. Review and Approval of the Final Minutes of Sept 2 meeting

2. Report of the LDAs - Jim, George

Hunter interviews will start during the week of September 20, 2010.

Location: in LL Conference Room of Town House; George G. will reserve and publicize for Con Com.

Spreadsheet availability will be responsibility of Jim P. He will share it with George G. for tracking. Final version will be made available to BOH.

Area assignments with stakeholders will be handled as previously discussed: representative of stake holder, LDA, and Hunters will survey areas together. As season progresses, hunters that hunt together will organize themselves if necessary and keep LDA informed. George G. has been assigned by Con Com to be their representative.

Interaction with Dover PD: discussion resulted in two decisions: sensitive data like SS # and dob will not be entered into the spread sheet, rather be given to PD independently. Only Jim P has access to that data. In addition, the suggestion of the acting PD Chief to have hunters call the PD every time they enter Dover Land was discussed. A vote for or against this suggestion resulted in 8:0 against such a requirement.

3. Report of DLCT decision of Sept 15 – George

George G. attended the meeting, but no decision was made in his present. Post-meeting note: Subsequent to our meeting at 10:00 AM, BRS was informed by DLCT that they will make the **Gregg Property** available for our pilot DMP program. (Thank you, George!)

4. Discussion of planned signage for DMP – All

It was decided that the BOH Dover Regs will be publicized extensively. Only one general sign about hunting season will be posted at trails and entrances. All other signs are the responsibility of the stake holders.

5. Presentation and review of ID tags – Diane

Three laminated ID tags will be provided for the hunter: one small one to carry in the wallet (white), one (black and white) to be displayed on the dash board of the car, and one (chocolate-brown and black) to be displayed at the tree stand. The ID tag will display # of the BOH license, make and color of car and license plate of car (no name of individual)

6. Presentation of new regional information – Barbara, Diane

Barbara was contacted by the chair of the newly-formed Medfield Lyme Disease Committee with a request for information and potential collaboration. Diane spoke to her counterpart of the Westwood BOH and was told that they might want to join our efforts some time in the future.
