- The Committee discussed having a sub-committee put together the questionnaire after all information is turned in. P. Angelico suggested we could use a past survey as a footprint. M. Sarro discussed what format might be best. R. Forte brought up the question of how would the issue of increase in taxes impact the project. These questions will be discussed further at Dec. meeting.
- W. Weld stated that the petitioners for sidewalks are having a tour of sites on Saturday, November 13th at 8:00AM. The petitioners will also be attending the Long Range Planning Committee Meeting in December.
