

MEETING MINUTES
BOARD OF SELECTMEN
JUNE 25, 2010

At 7:31 a.m., Chairman Joseph M. Melican called the meeting to order with members Carol Lisbon and James P. Dawley, Jr. present. Also present were David W. Ramsay, Town Administrator, and Greer Pugatch, Assistant Town Administrator.

Appoint Selectmen's Collective Bargaining Representative to the Dover & Dover-Sherborn Regional School Committees

Mr. Melican asked the Board to formally vote to appoint a Selectmen's representative to the negotiating team for a successor contract for the teachers belonging to the Dover-Sherborn Education Association.

Mr. Dawley moved to appoint Carol Lisbon as the Board of Selectmen's collective bargaining representative to the Dover, Dover-Sherborn and Sherborn School Committees, seconded by Mrs. Lisbon; it was unanimously voted.

Mrs. Lisbon updated the other Board members on the status of school committee activities as they prepare to commence negotiations with the teachers' association. There will be a total of 16 representative votes between the 3 school committees on June 29, 2010 to determine who will be on the negotiating team. It is Mrs. Lisbon's sense that the Dover and the Dover-Sherborn School Committees will support the appointment of a Selectman to that team, as desired. There have different interpretations on whether one Selectman each from Dover and Sherborn get to vote on the terms of the final agreement or just one Selectman representative for the two towns.
