

DOVER CEMETERY COMMISSIONERS MINUTES  
TUESDAY, AUGUST 17, 2010

Meeting opened at 6:35 p.m. in the conference room in the Town Garage.

Attendance – Bill Herd, Jon Wolff, and Carol Jackman.

Minutes of the June 22, 2010 meeting were approved.

COMMENTS: D. Preston Hall was in attendance and presented plans for a new well at his home on Old Meadow Road. He was at the meeting to request permission to enter the back of his property via the cemetery roads. The committee SO VOTED to allow him to do this with the contingency that the width of the walls and gates will admit the truck without doing any damages. He is also required to submit a signed statement stating that any damages incurred would be paid in full by him.

**NEW BUSINESS –**

A deed was signed for Susan Ellis and a schedule of payments to the treasurer in the amount of \$2,500 was signed and ready for submission to the Town Clerk and Treasurer, respectively.

The bill warrant was signed after review.

Confirmation of the new Open Meeting Law form was signed by all three members of the commission.

**OLD BUSINESS**
