

DOVER CEMETERY COMMISSIONERS MINUTES
TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 21, 2010

Meeting opened at 6:32 p.m. in the conference room at the Town Garage.

Attendance – Bill Herd, Jon Wolff, Carol Jackman, and Lawrence “Rusty” Dauphinee.

CITIZEN’S COMMENTS: Three citizens were in attendance to further understand why the cemetery would be off limits for dogs. After a lengthy discussion those in attendance felt they understood the problem better. One citizen from Walpole Street had hoped that we could find other avenues to explore, but when she realized that the commissioners had been working on this for a few years and that the decision had been made she left disappointed that she would no longer be able to walk her two dogs in the cemetery.

MINUTES OF THE AUGUST 17, 2010 MEETING were then read and approved.

NEW BUSINESS –

The bill and payroll warrants were signed after review.

A letter from John McKeon regarding the McKeon family headstone was received. He requested permission to replace the current headstone with another granite headstone exactly the same and having the McKeon names on one side and the Giampietro on the other. The diagram was approved and SO VOTED.

The Selectmen’s meeting for all Board Chairman was being held at the same time as our posted meeting so we did not have representation at that meeting unfortunately.

The Capital Budge Request form was discussed at this meeting and it was noted that the Cemetery Commissioner’s were not requesting any new items over \$4,000 at this time.

OLD BUSINESS

A report was given that D. Preston Hall’s new well at 18 Old Meadow Road has been started and that all requirements have been met. Mr. Hall plans on having the final stages done on Tuesday, September 28, 2010 and thanks the commissioners for their help.

Rusty gave a report stating that due to the summer heat the last month had been taken up with extra watering, mowing, trimming, weeding, and seeding of the cemetery. The equipment was maintained all month and the Gator was painted. All his filings were sent to the Town offices in a timely fashion. He also noted that there were two cremations last month and one sale of a lot.

Meeting closed at 8:00 pm. Next meeting was scheduled for October 26, 2010 at 6:30 pm at the Town Garage.
