

DOVER CEMETERY COMMISSIONERS MINUTES

MINUTES of the December 15, 2009 meeting were approved.

NEW BUSINESS –

Two deeds were signed.

Layout of Block G, changing to all four grave lots, was approved and SO VOTED.

A family had filed papers and a check to purchase a lot in a section that has not been laid out as yet. It was the decision of those commissioners at the meeting to have the family reapply for an area of the cemetery that has already been laid out.

A question was received about lots 23 and 24 from a family member. It was decided to research the issue further.

OLD BUSINESS

Further discussion was held re a five-year plan, for history purposes, as recommended by Jon Wolff and it was SO VOTED to go forward with the plan.
