- I. Vote to approve request to paint fire station floors and walls – 5-0 in favor.
- II. Motion to review the Chickering carpet request – 5-0 in favor.
- III. Discussion – color photos were shown of the carpet. Based on the photos and visual inspection by two members, the carpet did not appear to be worn. Vote 0-5 against.
- IV. Motion to review Chickering request for replacement trees – 5-0 in favor.
- V. Discussion – Concern over the ability of the school to properly water the trees arose as the existing trees died. The school assured the Committee that watering bags would be added to the trees so they would survive. 1-4 against. The Committee did not think this was an expense warranted at this time.

 - a. Park & Recreation – Updated Committee that P&R is meeting with other committees and is hopeful to present a plan to the Warrant Committee Open Hearing on March 22nd.
