**Requests for Determination**

Dover Land Conservation Trust , Pine St. #80

Present: Boynton Glidden, Ranger, DLCT

Notice having been duly published, the hearing was opened for Dover Land Conservation Trust

Mr. Glidden explained his plans to clear brush. No trees larger than 4" will be cut without permission. Discussion about 1 dead tree to be cut.

Motion made, seconded and unanimously voted to close the hearing.

Motion made, seconded and unanimously voted to issue a Negative Determination based on facts presented by Mr. Glidden.

Dover Land Conservation Trust , Farm St. #3

Notice having been duly published, the hearing was opened for Dover Land Conservation Trust

No trees greater than 4" will be cut without permission. Dead trees and brush may be taken down. Brush to be removed off side of driveway.

Motion made, seconded and unanimously voted to close the hearing.

Motion made, seconded and unanimously voted to issue a Negative Determination based on facts presented by Mr. Glidden.

74 Farm Street, Fiske DEP #144-656

Present: Chris Polatin, Polatin Ecological Services and Elaine Fiske, applicant

Mr. Polatin outlined the revised Notice of Intent proposal. He reviewed a memo dated Feb. 10, 2011 from Mr. Paul McManus of EcoTec Inc. Environmental Consulting Services.

Agent Giunta said the Order of Conditions will be monitored. He recommended a silt fence for erosion control in the upland area. He said silt fence is also possible on the downslope side. He will make periodic inspections.

Discussion was held about the tree cutting process. Ms. Fiske said Bartlett Tree will remove the trees in sections.

The Commission addressed abutter concerns. The wind movement is loosening the trees and so loosening the berm. If the trees do not come out, the berm and the pond will disappear. The tree removal is to protect the pond. This is a preservation project recommended by the Commission's Wetland Scientist and it will be monitored.

Motion made and seconded to close the hearing and accept the plan as presented with the addition of hand-pulling of purple loosestrife, note also the buffer zone area on the plan and discussion of possible silt fence and periodic visits from the Conservation Agent. Also the commission encourages the use of clay packing for the burrows.
