

Minutes of the Town of Dover, Board of Health meeting for June 11, 2012

Present: Members - Dr. Barbara Roth-Schechter (Acting Chairperson); Dr. Harvey George; Agent - Mike Angieri, Septic.

- 1) Meeting Called to Order at 7:05 PM.
- 2) SPAN. Members of SPAN presented a discussion of their activities and programs which are partially funded by the Board of Health. They discussed their 2 year survey in the metro West region and the need to reach children at the 5th grade level and their parents. Their recent programs have seen a significant growth in parents attending. They thanked the Board for their continuing financial assistance.
- 3) Minutes of the May 14, 2011 meeting were approved.
- 4) 4 Crest Drive. Public hearing for the up-grade of a septic system. Abutters were notified and one from 3 Crest Drive was present to listen to the discussion. Joe Nihill of GLM presented the plan. It is an up-graded septic system for the 3 bedroom house. They are seeking variances from Dover's regulations, chapter 217-3(7)a part of the system within 100 feet of the well, but meeting Title V. Site will have a deed restriction due to the use of the FAST treatment system. Ground water separation will be 2 feet. System is sized for a garbage grinder. Board approved the variance, deed restriction and plan subject to final technical review.
- 5) 71 Claybrook Road. The owner, Larry Fisch asked the Board to allow him to substitute the Waterloo treatment system with a bottomless sand filter for use on this site as opposed to the previously approved FAST treatment system with pressure dosing bed. This system allows the use of a smaller leaching bed which will result in less flood plain disturbance. The Board approved the use of the alternative treatment system.
- 6) Deed restrictions. The Board approved and signed deed restrictions for: 153 Pine Street; 48 Pine Street; 90 Claybrook Road; and 17 Bretton Road.
- 7) Lyme Disease Committee. Their intern has started work and will be collecting tick population samples for further study.
- 8) Master Plan. The Board reviewed the Master Plan outline where it involved the Board of Health. The Board agrees with the plan, particularly: Improving emphasis on ground water protection; Providing Social Services (Reach Out style programs and the SPAN program); use of enhanced septic system treatment systems such as FAST and Waterloo Biofilter to improve ground water discharge quality; improving the office work space and use of electronic files for document processing.

- 9) Unresolved Septic Issues. The Board wants the town attorney to contact those septic system owner with advanced treatment system who have not responded to requests to maintain their system, with the Boards plan to have the systems inspected and bill the owners for that cost to bring the units into compliance with Title V as they agreed to do when the systems were approved.
- 10) Meeting Schedule. The November 12 meeting was rescheduled to November 5, 2012.
- 11) New Chair. No action taken.
- 12) Septic Agent. Board voted to reappoint Mike Angieri as their septic Agent for the next year.
- 13) No discussion of Board of Health regulations.
- 14) The meeting was adjourned at 9:15 PM.
