We had tabled any bid work until other bids were received, but Bill had seen the tree company in the cemetery and he authorized them himself to remove some of the trees. The bid was to remove the stem of the red oak by the Wakelin/Maloney plots, cutting them into four foot lengths, grinding the oak stump and leaving the chips over the hole. Cost to be \$420. The cemetery crew would do the clean-up (thanks to Bob Beckwith for handling this in Rusty's absence and for always covering for us). We should also note that Craig Hughes has been wonderful helping the cemetery out through Rusty's illness. Bill also reported that by February 24th he hoped the big pine tree would be down by the Jackson grave.

Bill Herd reported he would try to get Dave Ramsey to contact Carol after work hours in order to schedule a meeting around her work schedule.
