**OLD BUSINESS**

It was SO VOTED to purchase two (2) granite posts for the new signs at a cost of \$903. The cost will come from Perpetual Care fund.

The White family application for a headstone was APPROVED.

Bill Hurd gave a report from the meeting with the Capitol budget group regarding the renovation request for the Hearse House. It was basically well received, but some of the members wanted a tour of both Hearse House and Rusty's current office before they could comment further. They did request an additional bid, of which Bill will get.

Discussion regarding the purchase of a compactor was TABLED as it was noted the Highway Dept. has two. Bill is to get quotes for smaller ones than the Highway Dept. compactors.

Removal of tree that was hit recently in a storm needed to be removed. It was SO VOTED to hire Tree Tech at a cost of \$2,050 as long as they had a crane to take it down.

**CORRESPONDENCE** - A letter was received regarding the McDowell plot and it was stated that the owner may authorize anyone they wish to be buried in their plot.
