Three bids were received for the painting of the truck and it was SO VOTED to hire JP Mayo from Sherborn at a cost of \$3,200.

Discussion continued about dividing some of the eight grave lots into two grave lots and it was voted to table until the committee has reviewed the section suggested.

A certified letter was received from Charles River School regarding a trail they plan to install. Also a letter was received regarding the donation of a light for the back flagpole, but the suggestion was for a shorter flagpole than ours.
