

Minutes of the Town of Dover Board of Health Meeting for November 24, 2014

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1. Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm.
2. The Board approved the minutes of November 3, 2014.
3. 5 Turtle Lane – This is a two bedroom house with a septic system designed and installed for four bedrooms and a garbage grinder. The Board voted to amend the plans to allow for the garbage grinder.
4. 25 Farm Street – This is a proposed pool house with half bath. The Board voted to approve the deed restriction subject to final review and approval by the Health Agent.
5. 43 Centre Street – This is a 3 bedroom house with three cesspools. The cesspools will be abandoned. The Board voted to approve the proposed plans for a septic system sized for a 4 bedroom house and garbage grinder subject to final review and approval by the Health Agent.
6. 68 Main Street– This is an existing house that will be torn down. The Board voted to approve the proposed plans for an Eljen system sized for a five bedroom house and garbage grinder subject to final review and approval by the Health Agent.
7. Inspection fee – The Board approved a fee of \$125 for each additional well inspection.
8. Water regulations – A few additional changes were made to the draft of the updated water regulations.
9. Water Quality Committee – The Board has decided not to move ahead with the Water Quality Committee, as the Board of Selectmen plans to create and appoint interested citizens to a Water Study Committee under their jurisdiction.
10. Senior tax work off – A new volunteer has been assigned to the office this year. Karen will meet with her to explain the tasks she will be assigned while working in the BOH office.
11. Administrative Support – Karen will work with Barbara and the Board to write the justification narrative on the need for additional BOH office hours.
12. The meeting adjourned at 8:40 pm.
