DOVER PLANNING BOARD MINUTES
April 7, 2014, Approved as Amended, May 12, 2014

Chair Mark Sarro called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM at the Dover Town House. Also present were Board members John Dougherty, Jane Remsen, and Planning Assistant Susan Hall¹

1. SIGN PERMIT, KIRBY FARM

Present was Mark Howe from the Calumet Corporation. Mr. Howe presented a rendering of the sign with details representing the developer, the real estate company and the name of the subdivision. There will be no lights. It measures 4 feet by 5 feet. After a brief discussion the Board agreed to approve the sign.

On a motion duly made and seconded, the Board voted to approve the sign permit for Kirby Farm as submitted. The motion passed unanimously with three members voting.

2. REGISTERED MARIJUANA DISPENSARY BYLAW

The Board discussed and finalized the language of the bylaw. The Board agreed to make a motion to approve the bylaw as written.

On a motion duly made and seconded, the Board voted to approve the Registered Marijuana Dispensary bylaw as written. The motion passed unanimously with three members voting.

3. DISCUSSION RE: HOUSE NUMBER CHANGE

The Board discussed the letter of request for a house number change for 74 Claybrook Road to 72 Claybrook Road. After a brief discussion the Board denied the request.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

On a motion duly made and seconded, the Board voted to approve the minutes, as written, for February 24, 2014. The motion passed unanimously with three members voting.
