1. Approval of minutes of prior meetings

Ms. Hunter moved that the minutes of the September 9 meeting be approved, seconded by Mr. Sarro. The motion was approved unanimously by all who had been in attendance.

2. Schedule for the Coming Year

It was agreed that meetings will continue to be at 7:00 pm on the first Tuesday of the month.

3. Green Community Certification

The Selectmen have been approached informally about Dover becoming certified as a Green Community, as has been done in Sherborn, Westwood, and other nearby towns. Such certification would entitle Dover to a share of State grants. Since the Planning Board has researched the program in the past, Mr. Sarro will invite Consulting Town Planner Gino Carlucci to our next meeting to explain the requirements.

4. Snyder Property

If the purchase of the Snyder property passes at the poll in November, the Selectmen will form an ad hoc committee to study and recommend how the Town should use the property. Several members of this Committee expressed interest in participating.

5. Caryl Community Center

Bathroom renovations and other physical plant projects will have to be addressed soon. It was agreed that there would be greater support if more people were aware of how busy Caryl is.
