1. Approval of minutes of prior meetings

2. Parks and Recreation

3. Caryl Community Center

Ms. Hunter is interested in figuring out what the operating and capital costs of the Center have been since the Town took the building over from the School in 2001. Then, she also wants to look at the state of the building and the likely timeline for future capital expenditures. This will provide a baseline for evaluating the ongoing operation of the Center. The Committee as a whole agreed that this is a worthwhile study, and Mr. Forté specifically agreed to assist in gathering and organizing the data.

Kathy Weld of the Caryl Management Advisory Committee will attend a future meeting to present their current outlook.

4. Other Business

Mr. Smith inquired as to recent funding of the Town's OPEB fund. Ms. Hunter volunteered to gather a summary of payments to the fund since the MTBE settlement.
