1. Approval of minutes of prior meetings

2. Master Plan follow-up

The Council on Aging continues to have trouble finding drivers to help Dover seniors get to appointments, shopping, and socializing. Doing so for pay or under the explicit auspices of the CoA opens up liability issues. Methods for encouraging volunteers and of matching volunteers with seniors in need were discussed. Mrs. Sheridan will inquire if the Town's insurance coverage extends to cover such arrangements.
