

DOVER CEMETERY COMMISSIONER'S MINUTES
APRIL 29, 2014

Meeting opened at 6:00 pm in the meeting room of the Town Garage

Attendance - Bill Herd, Pope Hoffman and Carol Jackman.

MINUTES OF MARCH 11, 2014 MEETING were approved.

CITIZEN COMMENT - None

DEEDS PRESENTED FOR SIGNING - Three deeds were presented for signing. Takashi and Teruko Maki, 391-6 Ueno, Nagaramachi, Choseigun, Chiba, Japan 297-0201 (formerly of Centre St., Dover), Lot 48, Block F, 4 grave. Caitlin Madera Fawcett and John H. Fawcett, Jr., 4 Hutton Road, Dover, Lot 7, Block F, 4 grave. Nathan P Couch, 5 High Rock Road, Dover, Lot 72, Block F, 2 grave.

It was reported that the water was turned on in late April and the Commissioners would like to see if it could be done April first. A letter will be sent to Colonial Water.

Three bids were received regarding a compactor for the cemetery. After much discussion regarding the fact the Highway Dept. had two or three compactors it was SO VOTED to purchase a Honda CX-120 for \$1,446 after the first of July. Cost to come from "new equipment". It will be purchased from Case of New England.

Restoration of stone wall by Charles River School was SO VOTED to have Strawberry Hill do the work at a cost of \$300. It was SO VOTED to have Strawberry Hill repair the wall by the flag pole that was damaged from plowing this winter at a cost of \$295. Cost of these projects will come from maintenance.

Rusty reported that only half the order of the corner markers were received for Block F.

Carol reported on the meeting with town officials regarding the Uniform Account for Highland Cemetery. As this was the only uniform account for a non-union member it needed to be repaid to the town as the amount did not get reported on a W-2.

Rusty mentioned the gravel in the back of the cemetery and suggested getting rid of it. The commissioners decided to leave it alone.

CORRESPONDENCE - The Brown family submitted plans for a boulder headstone, to be installed by Natick Memorial Works. The commissioners SO VOTED approval of the headstone.
