It was reported that the stonewall by the Charles River School was repaired by Strawberry Hill, but the committee was not happy with the end result. Members of the committee could not understand why Strawberry Hill did not pick up the stones that had fallen on the Charles River School property. Rusty would be asked to call Strawberry Hill and ask them to come back and complete the repair of the wall.

The committee then discussed the fact that flowers from a funeral must be removed two weeks after the funeral. Rusty needs to be reminded of this because by that time the flowers are dead and do not make the area look nice, especially when another funeral is held in the same area. This happened when two funerals were conducted within the viewing of dead flowers on another grave.
