### **Acceptance of Meeting Minutes for May 6, 2014 Meeting**

#### **New Business:**

#### **Demo Request –80 Wilsondale Avenue;**

The request to demolish a barn and shed built before 1929 according to the assessor's records and to build a detached garage on basically the same footprint.

The house at 80 Wilsondale Street is called Quinnebequinn Farm and has a Historical placard on the property with the date of 1915.

The Historical Commission reviewed the demolition permit paper work and decided to travel to the location—80 Wilsondale Street.

After inspection of the Barn and Shed the Historical Commission moved to vote on the request for demolition permit. A motion was made that the 2 (two) buildings –barn and shed are deemed of no "Historical Significance" value and the Commission will allow for demolition of the barn and shed for the detached garage. The vote being unanimous--- 4 (Ayes) for demolition and 0 (Nay) votes (4 votes for to issue demolition permit and 0 votes). The Historical Commission will notify the Building Inspector via a letter to issue a demolition permit for demolition of the barn and shed.
