

DOVER CEMETERY COMMISSIONER'S MINUTES

WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 28, 2015

Meeting opened at 7:00 pm with Pope Hoffman and Carol Jackman attending the Town of Dover Warrant Committee's meeting.

Chairman James Stuart opened the meeting with the first item on their agenda being the budget for Highland Cemetery. Pope Hoffman presented the request for increases in some areas to reflect the actual expenses in 2014. The largest request was for the maintenance on the cemetery truck due to its age. The increase in the operation of the cemetery, other than salaries, came to \$612. Pope also announced to the committee the name of our new committee member, Helena Wylde Swiny. Various members asked questions regarding the cemetery and they wanted to know if the water feature was still being considered. Pope did inform them that the members had voted to not proceed with the water feature, but to hopefully have a meditation garden in an area close to the original plans for the water feature.
