

**Dover Warrant Committee**  
**Minutes of the December 9<sup>th</sup>, 2015 meeting**

Mr. Lawrence called the meeting to order at 7:05 P.M.

The Committee reviewed the minutes of October 28<sup>th</sup>, November 4<sup>th</sup>, and November 18<sup>th</sup>. The Committee delayed voting to approve minutes for pending corrections.

Mrs. Cannie updated the committee on the Caryl Community Center and the Board of Selectmen's support of the decision to relocate the men's bathroom.

Mr. Lawrence informed the committee that a special town meeting would be scheduled to address the issue of Minuteman and the decision of the town of Dover to remain/or not remain a member of the Minuteman Regional Vocational Technical School District. Ms. McCann provided a brief overview of the process to be followed at town meeting.

Mr. Lawrence informed the committee that warrant articles for the ATM 16 include the Green Community Act and the Dover Rail Trail.

Mrs. Gerner presented an overview of the Regional School District budget. She informed the committee that Dover's assessment, which is based on enrollment, increased by 1.45%. The Committee was asked to submit any questions regarding the RSC budget to either Mrs. Gerner or Mr. Gill-Body so that they may be submitted to Michael Lee.

Mr. Merrill informed the committee, with regards to the Fire Department's budget, that Permanent Part Time would replace the expense under FTE.

Mrs. Cannie informed the Committee that the Dover School Committee would be reviewing its budget at the December 15<sup>th</sup> meeting.

The next meeting is schedule for January 6<sup>th</sup>, at 7:00 P.M. at Dover Town House.

Being no other business, Mr. Stuart made a motion to adjourn, second my Mr. Merrill. The meeting adjourned at 8:30 PM
