

DOVER CEMETERY COMMISSIONER'S MINUTES
FEBRUARY 17, 2015

Meeting opened at 6:00 pm in the meeting room of the Town Garage

Attendance - Pope Hoffman, Laina Swiny and Carol Jackman.

MINUTES OF JANUARY 20, 2015 were approved.

CITIZEN'S COMMENTS - None.

Copies of payroll and bill warrants were signed.

There were no deeds presented for signing.

Laina Wylde-Swiny was welcomed to the Commission and presented with hours of readings in order to inform her of recent decisions.

Chairman Pope Hoffman presented drawings from Nature Works pertaining to the Meditation Garden in memory of Heather Tourtellotte. The plantings were discussed and it was decided before purchasing any plants for the area the Commissioner's would consult a number of people to get recommendations for easy to care for plantings. The next step is for Pope to visit Ed Tourtellotte and show him the plans for his approval. This project is being paid for from donations in memory of Heather Tourtellotte.

A discuss was then held regarding another grave site that had been sold to a family and that had never been recorded in the cemetery registry plot plan. Fortunately this grave site had not been resold like the other one had been. The error is now corrected.

The Commissioners then discussed winter burials during the current condition of the cemetery. Due to the amount of snow this year one is unable to even see a headstone and there would be a concern of damaging headstones if Rusty were to clear a lot for a burial. It was SO VOTED that there would be no further burials until the headstones could be seen. Funeral directors would be informed of our vote if they had a need for a burial and hoped they would work with us.

Rusty did not have a report for the meeting.
