

DOVER CEMETERY COMMISSIONER'S MINUTES
JULY 21, 2015

Meeting opened at 9:00 am at the Town Garage.

Attendance - Pope Hoffman and Carol Jackman

MINUTES OF JUNE 16, 2015 were approved.

There were no Citizen comments

Two deeds were signed - one deed for Elizabeth Ryan, 8 Overlook Ter, Walpole 02081 (formerly of Dover) for Lot #18, Block G, four grave and a deed for Gary F Mitchell, 3 Draper Rd, Dover for Lot 48, Block G, four grave. Cost for each deed was \$7,600.

Pope then discussed flat markers for the two grave lots. He also mentioned that the pruning of bushes needed to be done on the hill and he would mention it to Rusty. He then said he would be sure that Dover Farms was aware of the stop work order when funerals were going to be held. When he talks to Rusty he will also mention the stonewall by Charles River School and that he would go over and check it out after the meeting.

A headstone application was received and it was rejected because of being over the size requirements. Rusty would be asked to inform the family.

Pope then stated a concern about the construction costs of the Meditation Garden and whether we would have to put it out for bid. He said he would check it out with Dave Ramsey and report back at the next meeting.
