**Acceptance of the Minutes**----The Minutes for the February 3, 2015 Meeting were approved.

### **Old Business:**

**95 FARM Street** –The Commission acknowledged that we all had received Jane’s e-mail that she had informed the Building Inspector that the Historical Commission had decided that the older house section of c.1650’s could be removed to storage or to the potential location of Long Island.

**Brook Sign Project**-- Commission discussed the Brooks, that cross under the roads, should have one or two signs. There was some discussion on the color and size of the sign. The Commission should check with the Selectmen on the nature of signs throughout the town and who is responsible for them. Robyn said she would check into the matter. Suggested that Commission’s Members look at signs as we travel the roads to see what is a good sign. Suggested this would be a great Eagle Scout project.

Paul stated that Bob Homer and he had identified several of these Brooks years ago throughout the Town of Dover.

**Assessor’s List** — Paul stated that the list that Richard and Paul have of the older homes (built before 1929) in Dover are the same list. Barrie has a list of homes from the assessor’s office and we should check them with the list that Paul and Richard have.

**Peabody Sundial** --Paul stated that he was not able to get the Eagle Scout to come for a picture of the Sundial at its new library location before the winter. Paul said that Jim McLaren, consultant on the project, offered to come and take a current picture of the Sundial’s new location in the spring for any publications
