Old Business

- Warrant Article II: Caryl Restroom Renovation – It was decided to revisit this item. J. Dawley stated the cost for the bathroom renovations will be paid from free cash and will not impact real estate taxes. This warrant article has the full support of all the tenants in the building as well as the Park and Recreation Department. The proposed storage area accessed through the Director's office is a privacy space to be used for the storage of confidential information and other material the Director considers necessary. The COA space is being reconfigured but no space is being lost. J. Dawley stated if additional space is required, it can be carved out.

- G. Thisse felt the bathroom renovation should have a drain for the future need of a shower. Presently this building is used as an emergency shelter but in the future might contain elderly day care. This is a viable option as people age. It would be cost effective to do this now during the renovations.

A motion was made by L. Theodos and seconded by G. Thisse for the COA to support the bathroom renovation at the May 4th Annual Town Meeting. All in favor.
