The Dover Historical Commission met on Friday morning, November 4, 2016 to do a Site Visit at 4 Haven Terrace and to discuss the request for a demolition permit for the House and Garage at 4 Haven Terrace which was built c.1910 per the Assessor's records.

The Commission, in accordance with Chapter 96 of the By-Laws of the Town of Dover, voted that the house and garage at 4 Haven Terrace is of NO "Historical Significance" to the Town of Dover especially in its present state of condition.

The vote was unanimous to allow demolition of the structures (House and Garage) at 4 Haven Terrace

The Historical Commission will notify Walter Avallone, the building inspector, by official letter to allow him to issuing a demolition permit on these structures.
