MINUTES OF JANUARY 19, 2016 and JANUARY 27, 2016 were approved

Citizen's comments - None

Signed the Payroll and Bill Warrants.

There were no headstone applications for review.

Pope reported that he had received the survey of the cemetery. He will get four copies of the plans so that each Commissioner and Rusty will have them.

Laina reported that she had been in contact with Nature Works and has had discussions about the Spring plans and start date. She will get back to the Commissioners with the final plans.

It was SO VOTED to remove the Lyme Disease signs from the trees in the cemetery. Rusty would be instructed to do this in the morning.

The Commissioners reviewed bids for the fertilizing program and moth care. It was SO VOTED to hire Lynch Plant Healthcare to do the fertilizing and grub prevention this season at a cost of \$1,620 each for five different applications during the summer and fall. It was also VOTED to have them do the Winter Moth treatment at a cost of \$2,421.06. This is the same cost as last year even though the price would normally be \$3,200 this year.

There was no report from Rusty.
