A deed was presented for review and signed for Helen Florsheim, 11 Sterling Drive, Dover for Lot Number 87, Block F, 2 grave. \$3,800 was collected for this sale.

A headstone application was received from the Thomas Baker family who now resides at 629 South Street, Wrentham. The headstone size conformed to the requirements of Highland Cemetery, it was SO VOTED to approve the application.

The next step would be to walk the grounds (of which Laina has offered to do this with Rusty) to be sure we have enough concrete markers to complete the project.
