

DOVER CEMETERY COMMISSIONER'S MINUTES
JUNE 21, 2016

Meeting opened at 6:00 pm at the Town Garage.

Attendance - Pope Hoffman, Laina Swiny and Carol Jackman

MINUTES OF MAY 10, 2016 was approved with one correction and MAY 25, 2016 approved as printed.

Citizen's comments - None

Bills and payroll warrants were signed.

Deeds were signed for Joseph and Freda Panto, 13 Valley Road, Dover for Lot 27, Block F, 6 grave at a cost of \$2,400 for lot, \$9,000 for perpetual care; Paul and Orlyn Reese, 8 Pleasant St., Dover, Lot 29, Block F, 4 grave at a cost of \$1,600 for lot, \$6,000 for perpetual care; and Philip and Jean McCarthy, 24 Tubwreck Dr., Dover, Lot 11, Block F, 6 grave at a cost of \$2,400 for lot, \$9,000 for perpetual care.

It was noted that a footmarker was chipped at the Elizabeth Waters lot by a cemetery worker and that it is the cost of the cemetery to repair the footmarker. Metrowest Monuments gave a price of \$259.35 to repair the marker. It was SO VOTED to accept the bid. A footmarker application was presented for the Boudreau lot and it was SO VOTED to accept as it was in compliance with the requirements.

Laina reported that Nature Works would start the plantings around September 17th in the Meditation Garden. Laina said she would speak with Craig Hughes about getting materials for a bench and the use of heavy equipment to move the granite from the Town Garage to the Cemetery.

Pope reported that the new plans for the cremation section were done, but the drawings were not ready for the meeting.

Discussion about a Friends organization was tabled until after a tour of Mt. Auburn with Mr. Barnet.

Tree pruning was TABLED until John Gilbert reports back to Pope. The stonewall was discussed and bids should be available for the next meeting as to the cost of continuing the wall on the entrance side.

Rusty will be asked to start surveying neighboring towns as to whether they have a computer program specifically for their cemetery.

Meeting closed at 8:05 pm. Next meeting is to be July 19, 2016 at 6:00 p.
