

CEMETERY COMMISSIONERS MINUTES

AUGUST 11, 2016

The entire committee; Pope Hoffman, Laina Swiny, and Carol Jackman, attended the August 11th Selectmen's meeting to present information about the tree report received from Mr. Gilbert-Town Tree Warden. It was recommended that the committee get bids for the work that they wish to have done in the cemetery and the Selectmen would review the request. It should be noted that there are about one dozen trees that are in poor condition per Mr. Gilbert's report. The Selectmen would then make a decision as to accessing the money from one or both of the Chickering Funds.

The Commissioners will also put together a presentation and bids for extending the stone wall rather than replacing the fencing that now abuts the residents on Old Meadow Road. In the long run the stone wall will cut the cost of having to replace another fence in the future and will add to the historical aspect of stonewalls as property border lines.
