Meeting called to order at 10:05 a.m.

Program: Meet with Town Administrator

Town Administrator Chris Dwelley met with guests. He stated that COA and Director J. Claypoole is a strong Team member in working with the Town, and J. Claypoole is a member of the newly formed Town COVID-19 Preparedness Task Force.

Information was shared about the previous evening's Board of Selectmen meeting, including the presentation by Board of Health on COVID-19, risk to the community, and recommendations to close schools and other programs. Due to the high risk to those over age 60 and with chronic health conditions, the COA will suspend all programs at the end of day today. Outreach and supportive services will be available to seniors.

C. Dwelley fielded questions on Senior Tax Relief, Town Warrant Articles, and projects the Town is working on. He also discussed the Caryl Community Center and the plans to hire an Owners Project Manager and Design Team to work with the committee for a feasibility study of the building condition and determine criteria for a design plan.

A motion to adjourn was made at 11:15 a.m. by B. Cocks and seconded by M. Dilg. All in favor.
