**ARTICLES OF THE WARRANT
SPECIAL TOWN MEETING SEPTEMBER 15, 2014**

Norfolk, ss.

To any of the Constables of the Town of Dover in said County, Greetings;

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Dover, qualified as the Constitution requires to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet in the Alan Mudge Auditorium at the Dover-Sherborn Regional High School in said Town on Monday, the 15th day of September, 2014, at seven o'clock in the evening then and there to act on the following articles, to wit:

Article 1. (Selectmen) To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to acquire by purchase, exercise of first refusal option under Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 61A or otherwise, for general municipal purposes, on such terms and conditions as the Selectmen may determine, the fee in a parcel of land located at 46 Springdale Avenue shown on the Assessors maps as Parcel 11-049, and containing approximately 27.2 acres of land, known as the Snyder Property; and to see what sum of money the Town will raise and appropriate, appropriate by transfer from available funds, transfer, or borrow, or any combination of these methods, for the purpose of acquiring the Snyder Property; or take any other action relative thereto.

This article requires a two-thirds vote of the Special Town Meeting.


Article 2. (Selectmen) To see what sum of money the Town will raise and appropriate, or appropriate by transfer from available funds, or any combination of these methods, to fund an ad-hoc committee to be appointed by the Board of Selectmen to study the possible uses for the Snyder Property, if such property is acquired by the Town; or take any other action relative thereto.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by (1) posting attested copies thereof on each of the bulletin boards erected in the Town House, at the Post Office, and in no less than three (3) other Public places where bills and notices are usually posted; and (2) mailing a copy thereof to or leaving same at the residence of every registered voter fourteen (14) days at least before the time of holding said Meeting.


Hereof fail not and make due return of the Warrant with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk at or before the time of the Meeting.




